Shery Huang obtained MEng in Materials Science and Engineering from Imperial College London. With her curiosity in science, she decided not to pursue job offers in the oil & gas industry, and instead entered into a PhD program in Physics in Cambridge. After completing her PhD studies, she was awarded an Oppenheimer Research Fellowship and Homerton College Fellowship. Her current research employs Nanotechnology in medicine, example, to improve tissue implants, and to gain better understanding in disease mechanisms such as cancer metastasis. She is looking forward to joining the Engineering Department in August, when she will take up post University Lecturer Bioengineering.
